## Establishment of a report on the situation of refugees

### Motion for an Order

tabled by Mr Kurt Georg KIESINGER and other members of the Assembly

The Assembly,

Having regard to the number of refugees still remaining in camps in Europe;

Having regard to the proposals which it has made itself, and to the work done by other international organisations, for assistance to refugees;

Considering it desirable to make a new effort to liquidate the refugee problem in Europe,\*\* U

Instructs its Social Committee to present to it a short report, prepared in collaboration with the other international organisations concerned, which will show succinctly :

1. how many refugees are still remaining in camps in Europe and where they are situated ;
2. what is being done to find permanent homes and, where possible, permanent employment for them; and
3. what further action, including the granting of funds, is necessary in order to settle, once and for all the refugee problem in Europe.
