Report on credentials

President of the Assembly

1. Following the examination of credentials of new representatives and substitutes appointed during the 2nd part of the 2010 session of the Assembly, and in accordance with Rule 6, paragraphs 1 and 4, of the Rules of Procedure, the President of the Assembly has received the credentials of representatives and substitutes which have been transmitted in due form by the competent authorities of member states for validation by the Standing Committee acting on behalf of the Assembly.
