## Frontier road traffic

### Motion for a recommendation

tabled by Mr Albert RÖMER, Mr Ludwig WEISS

The Assembly,

Considering that frontier road traffic has considerably increased in recent years in most Member States of the Council of Europe;

Considering that this situation calls for adequate international regulations on a multilateral basis,

Recommends that the Committee of Ministers should:

- a. draw up a draft European Agreement on frontier road traffic modelled on the bilateral Agreement signed by Switzerland and Austria on 22nd October 1958;
- b. submit this draft Agreement to the Member States of the Council of Europe for signature and ratification;
- c. keep the Assembly informed of the action taken on the present Recommendation.
