Special Message of the Committee of Ministers

Parliamentary Assembly

(a) The appropriate committees to which the draft programme of work, [Doc. 238](#), transmitted by the Committee of Ministers is referred for discussion shall draw up an opinion on the chapters concerning them and shall add such parts of earlier Recommendations and Resolutions as they may wish to see followed up, having reviewed the whole of the work previously undertaken.

(b) The Committee on General Affairs - in addition to its task of pronouncing an opinion on the political sections of the draft programme of work - shall co-ordinate the replies of the other Committees. Further, as part of the wider report which it has been instructed to prepare, it will be required to draft the Opinion of the Consultative Assembly on the draft programme. The Rapporteur of the Committee on General Affairs would thus be considered as general Rapporteur for the draft programme of work as a whole.

(c) When the Rapporteurs have prepared their draft Reports on those parts of the draft programme of work which would affect their own Committees, they shall get into touch with one another with a view to co-ordinating and harmonising the different sections of the opinion to be submitted.

(d) At the time the Report of the Committee on General Affairs is debated in the Assembly, the Rapporteurs of Committees will themselves present such parts of the draft Opinion of the Assembly on the programme of work as fall within the province of their particular committee.
