237	22nd Sitting 28th January	Committee on Agriculture	<i>Agricultural policies in Europe</i> The Assembly, Having taken note of the report on agricultural policies in Europe, presented by the Committee on Agriculture (Doc. 1878), Instructs the Committee on Agriculture to continue its study of agricultural policies in Europe and report to it periodically on current developments, giving special emphasis in its next report to the marketing of foodstuffs and the organisation of agricultural markets.
238	22nd Sitting 28th January	Economic Committee	<i>Commercial relations between the member States of the Council of Europe and the countries of Central and Eastern Europe</i> The Assembly, Having considered the report of the Economic Committee on commercial relations between member States of the Council of Europe and the countries of Central and Eastern Europe (Doc. 1867), Instructs the Economic Committee to continue its investigations of East-West commercial and economic relations.
239	24th Sitting 29th January	Social and Political Committees	<i>Initial measures for the achievement of free movement of manpower within Europe</i> The Assembly, Having taken note of the Social Committee's report on initial measures to achieve the free movement of manpower in Europe (Doc. 1890) ; Having noted the opinion of the Political Committee ; Instructs the Rapporteurs of the two above-mentioned Committees to take steps, in conjunction with the Secretary-General, to make known to the Commission of EEC the Assembly's views on this question and, in particular, to consider the possibility of adopting in the Council of Europe regulations similar to Regulations No. 38/64/CEE.
