



Recommendation 36 (1949)

Migrant workers

Parliamentary Assembly

(Doc. 79, Section III, 1st and 2nd sub-paras.)

The Assembly draws the attention of Member States to the importance of the problem of the emigration of workers, as it exists since the war, due to the demographic and economic conditions in Europe countries.

As far as Member States are concerned, it believes that countries which accept workers from other countries should grant them the same social rights as those of the workers who are nationals of the country itself.
