



Recommendation 131 (1957)¹

Broadcasting station Europe No. 1

Parliamentary Assembly

The Assembly,

Noting that the settlement of the Saar question has placed the broadcasting station Europe No. 1 located at Sarre-louis in an anomalous position;

Noting that the French Government has certain claims on this station and could, with the consent of Parliament, offer to purchase it;

Noting further that a proposal to this effect made in the French National Assembly has been rejected because the intention is to demolish the station;

Considering that the equipment of the Europe No. 1 station might, if transferred to a suitable place, such as Strasbourg, provide the European institutions with a valuable means of disseminating information,

Recommends that the Committee of Ministers consider jointly, with other European institutions, the possibility of concluding an agreement with the French Government for operating the broadcasting station.
