



Recommendation 145 (1957)¹

Report by the Special Committee of the United Nations General Assembly on the Hungarian problem

Parliamentary Assembly

The Standing Committee,

Having taken note of the report on Hungary drawn up by the Special Committee of the United Nations General Assembly (Doc. UNO A/3592) ;

Considering that this report deserves the special attention of world public opinion,

Recommends that the Committee of Ministers take appropriate steps to ensure that the Member States of the Council of Europe which are also Members of the United Nations request that this report be debated without delay in the General Assembly of the United Nations, in any case before the close of that Assembly's 11th Ordinary Session.
