



Recommendation 342 (1963)¹

Ratification of Council of Europe Agreements on medical matters

Parliamentary Assembly

The Assembly,

Recalling its [Opinion No. 9](#) on the Special Message from the Committee of Ministers regarding the social programme of the Council of Europe ;

Considering it desirable that all member States of the Council of Europe should as soon as possible sign the five medical Agreements drawn up by the Council of Europe ;

Considering it important that these Agreements should be ratified as soon as possible,

Recommends that the Committee of Ministers :

- a. invite member countries which have not yet signed or ratified the following five Agreements to do so without delay :
 1. War cripples,
 2. Exchange of therapeutic substances of human origin,
 3. Medical and surgical equipment,
 4. Mutual medical assistance,
 5. Exchange of reagents;
- b. communicate to the Assembly any reasons for failure to sign or ratify or for delay in signing or ratifying these Agreements.
