# Right of conscientious objection

Parliamentary Assembly

The Assembly,

1. Having regard to its [Resolution 337](#) on the right of conscientious objection,
2. to instruct the Committee of Experts on Human Rights to formulate proposals to give effect to the principles laid down by the Assembly in its [Resolution 337](#) by means of a Convention or a recommendation to Governments so that the right of conscientious objection may be firmly implanted in all member States of the Council of Europe ;
