



Resolution 20 (1952)¹

Appointment of a Special Committee on Municipal and Regional Affairs

Parliamentary Assembly

The Assembly,

Decides, in accordance with paragraph 2 of Rule 40 of the Rules of Procedure, to set up a Special Committee on Municipal and Regional Affairs.

Fixes the number of seats on the Committee at 19, two each for the British, French, German and Italian groups respectively and one each for the other groups of Representatives.

Instructs the said Committee to establish all necessary contacts with the organisations concerned, governmental or non-governmental ; to proceed to study European problems at the municipal and regional level ; to supply these organisations with all information in its possession likely to provide a basis of assessment or action ; and to report to the Assembly on any questions referred to it.
