



Resolution 8 (1949)

Majority required for votes on procedural matters

Parliamentary Assembly

(Extract from the Minutes of Proceeding of the 7th Sitting, 18th August, 1949)

The Assembly resolves that, in pursuance of Articles 29 and 30 of the Statute, resolutions on procedural matters will be adopted by a simple majority.

It resolves that, in the examination of a report, amendments to the explanatory memorandum will not be considered.
