



**Resolution 94 (1956)<sup>1</sup>**

## **Establishment of a more broadly-based Sub-Committee on Information within the Committee on Cultural and Scientific Questions**

Parliamentary Assembly

The Assembly,

Believing it essential that the Council of Europe be enabled to pursue an effective information policy ;

Bearing in mind that proposals for the reorganisation of the committee structure of the Consultative Assembly are now before the Committee on Rules of Procedure,

Resolves :

1. That, pending receipt of a definite opinion from the Committee on Rules of Procedure concerning the said committee structure, a more broadly-based Sub-Committee on Information be appointed within the Committee on Cultural and Scientific Questions, to ensure effective liaison between the Assembly and the Secretariat-General on information questions ;
2. That the membership of this Sub-Committee shall be broadened to include members of other Assembly Committees.
