



**Resolution 171 (1959)<sup>1</sup>**

## **Proposed European Conference of Ministers of Posts and Telecommunications**

Parliamentary Assembly

The Assembly,

Having regard to [Recommendation 206](#) on a proposed European Conference of Ministers of Posts and Telecommunications ;

Having regard also to Resolution (58) 21 of the Committee of Ministers concerning European co-operation in the field of posts and telecommunications,

Resolves to ask members to introduce in its own Parliament an appropriate text designed to ensure that each Member Government :

1. will instruct its delegates to the European Conference of Posts and Telecommunications Administrations to treat that Conference as preparatory to a European Conference of Ministers of Posts and Telecommunications, as proposed by the Assembly, and to take whatever further measures are necessary to continue the Conference's work on a ministerial basis at an early date ;
2. will instruct its representative on the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe to support the implementation of [Recommendation 206](#) and to give whatever assistance may be needed therein.
