## Post-monitoring dialogue with Turkey

### Amendment<sup>1</sup> No. 10

*In the draft resolution, after paragraph 15.8, insert the following paragraph:*

"While acknowledging the importance of minority schools for the preservation of the identity of the national minorities, the Assembly, nevertheless, regrets that the law of 2007 on private teaching establishments did not reflect the requirements set forth in paragraph 19.14 of the Assembly Resolution 1704(2010). Therefore the Assembly urges Turkey to adapt the legislation so as to allow children from non-Muslim minorities, but without Turkish nationality, to be admitted to minority schools. In this regard the Assembly, while taking into account the reciprocity practice applied in certain cases, notes that ad hoc solutions are not a sufficient remedy for the problem."
