## **Activities of the Assembly's Bureau and Standing Committee (7 April 2014)**

### **Progress report**

### **1. Decisions of the Bureau of 7 April 2014 requiring ratification by the Assembly**

#### **1.1. Election observation**

*1.1.1. "The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia": presidential election (13 and 27 April 2014) and early parliamentary elections (27 April 2014)*

The Bureau approved the final composition of the ad hoc committee (Appendix 1).

*1.1.2. Early presidential election in Ukraine (25 May 2014)*

The Bureau approved the composition of the ad hoc committee, decided to increase the number of members of the ad hoc committee to 52: in accordance with the D'Hondt system, SOC: 16, EPP/CD: 16, EDG: 8, ALDE: 7, UEL: 3 and the two co-rapporteurs of the Monitoring Committee, and appointed Mr Andreas Gross (Switzerland, SOC) as chairperson (Appendix 2).
