## Re-fashioning of European Organizations

### Conclusions<sup>1</sup>

Parliamentary Assembly

#### **1. RECOMMENDATION TO THE COMMITTEE OF MINISTERS adopted 23rd November 1950 at the conclusion of the Debate on the Third Report from the Committee on General Affairs**

The Assembly,

Considering it to be of the greatest importance that it shall be able to follow the work of the chief European or international intergovernmental organizations and to submit suitable Recommendations to the Committee of Ministers concerning the direction of their work;

Requests that all practical steps be taken to enable it to undertake this task, particularly by placing adequate means at the disposal of the Secretariat-General and by the establishment of organic links with the organizations referred to above;

Requests that the representatives of its competent Committees be invited to take part in any governmental conference organized to discuss subjects appearing on the Agenda of the Assembly;

Renews its Recommendations contained in Doc. 74, Paras. 1 (iv) and 2 of 18th August 1950;

Considering that the final aim is the integration of O. E. E. C. and of the social and cultural organisms of the Brussels Treaty Powers within the Council of Europe, but that immediate action is necessary;

Draws particular attention to the urgent need of taking suitable action on its Recommendations contained in Doc. 74, Para. 1.(i) and (ii) of 18th August 1950.
