Witness protection as an indispensable tool in the fight against organised crime and terrorism in Europe

Parliamentary Assembly

1. Referring to its [Resolution 2038 \(2015\)](#) on witness protection as an indispensable tool in the fight against organised crime and terrorism in Europe, the Parliamentary Assembly recommends that the Committee of Ministers:

- 1.1. take stock of the implementation of its Recommendation Rec(2005)9 on the protection of witnesses and collaborators of justice;
- 1.2. undertake a comprehensive study on the design and operation of witness protection programmes in all Council of Europe member States, in particular with respect to incentives for co-operation of collaborators of justice, in order to harmonise, where necessary, rules for the transnational implementation of such measures;
- 1.3. encourage member States to collect and share statistics on the results of co-operation of witnesses and collaborators of justice with the investigative and judicial authorities, in particular the number of convictions based on their testimonies.
