Role of the Council of Europe in the economic field

Motion for a resolution

tabled by Mr Félix GAILLARD, Mr Edouard BONNEFOUS

The Assembly believing that, in order to achieve genuine European economic co-operation, it would be desirable to undertake without further delay a study of the pooling of all the basic resources of Europe with a common administration by all the different countries of Europe, requests its Committee on Economic Questions.

- a. to submit to it at its next session a plan for the European grouping of coal which would include as a part of the goods held in common the coalfields of the Ruhr, to which all European states, including Germany, but not Germany exclusively, should have access.
- b. to study plans for a European grouping of transport, steel and electricity.
