Political prosecutions undermine the trust in the Kazakhstani justice system

Written declaration No. 660

This written declaration does not reflect the position of the Assembly; only of those members that have signed it. It will not be considered further by the Assembly.

Although Kazakhstan is about to evaluate the Joint Programme “Support to the Kazakhstani authorities in improving the quality and efficiency of the Kazakhstani justice system”, it isn’t going to bring Kazakhstan’s criminal justice framework, or its institutional practice, any closer to European and international standards.

Recent developments, mentioned in the written declarations 652 and 655, as well as the systemic use of torture in detention facilities, the lack of investigation into allegations of torture also evoke grave concern, as evidenced in cases of political prisoners, such as Maks Bokayev, Aron Atabek, and Mukhtar Dzhakishev who may die at any moment, as he is held in isolation and denied visits by international observers. The case of Iskander Yerimbetov, deprived of the right to a fair trial, or misuse of INTERPOL and politically motivated extradition request in the case of blogger Muratbek Tungishbayev also serve as illustrative examples.

We particularly regret that more than 140 participants in the peaceful protests of 10 May and 23 June 2018 have been persecuted for executing their right to peacefully demand that the political oppression and torture be stopped, and advocating for free education.

We strongly condemn such practices and call Kazakhstan to fulfill its international obligations.
