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Respect of human rights of the Bulgarian national minority in Serbia

In its reply to written question No. 616/2012 ([Doc. 12935](#)), the Committee of Ministers stated that religious freedom is protected under both Article 9 of the European Convention on Human Rights and Article 8 of the Framework Convention for the Protection of National Minorities.

The Bulgarian national minority which is living in Serbia following the change of borders after the Peace Treaty of Neuilly is still deprived of the right to worship in its mother tongue. At the same time, the Romanian ethnic minority living there has gained the freedom of worship in its language. There should be no double standards in such cases.
