Examination of credentials of representatives and substitutes

Report on credentials

1. In accordance with Rule 6, paragraphs 1 and 4, of the Rules of Procedure, the President of the Assembly has received the credentials of representatives and substitutes which have been transmitted in due form by the competent authorities of member States for ratification by the Standing Committee.
2. The Standing Committee, acting on behalf of the Assembly, is called upon to take a decision on the ratification of the credentials of the representatives and substitutes whose names are given below.
3. **Finland** has appointed a new substitute following the resignation of Mr Mikko Polvinen.
4. **France** has modified the composition of its delegation following parliamentary elections.
5. The **Netherlands** has appointed a new substitute following the resignation of Ms Tanja Klip-Martin.
6. **Poland** has appointed a new substitute following the resignation of Mr Bogdan Klich.
7. **Romania** has appointed a new representative following the resignation of Ms Maria-Gabriela Horga.
8. The **United Kingdom** has modified the composition of its delegation following parliamentary elections.
9. In case of objection or justified contestation, the contested credentials shall be referred without debate to the appropriate committee, which shall report back to the Assembly in accordance with Rules 7 and 8 of the Rules of Procedure.
