### 1. Decisions of the Bureau of 27 June 2025 requiring ratification by the Assembly

#### 1.1. References to committees

On the basis of a proposal by the Group of the European People's Party, the Bureau nominated Ms Christine Pasquier-Ciulla (Monaco) as a representative.
