This reorientation prioritises unilateral conceptions of sovereignty, the subordination of multilateral institutions to narrowly defined national interests, and a shift towards power-based approaches that weaken the universality and binding force of international law with direct implications for Europe's security architecture and the credibility of the rules-based international order."

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
