1. Decisions of the Bureau of 20 April 2026 requiring ratification by the Assembly

2.1.1. Requests for debates under urgent procedure

The Bureau took note:

- of the request to hold a debate on *Request for opinion on the draft additional protocol to the Council of Europe Convention on Laundering, Search, Seizure and Confiscation of the Proceeds from Crime and on the Financing of Terrorism*: decided to recommend to the Assembly to hold this debate, and to refer the matter to the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights for report;
- of the request to hold a debate on *Suspension of Israel's observer status with the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe in light of systemic violations of international law*: decided to recommend to the Assembly not to hold this debate;
- of the request to hold a debate on *Addressing Israel's death penalty law in Occupied Palestinian territories in the context of Council of Europe standards*: decided to recommend to the Assembly not to hold this debate.

2.1.2. Request for current affairs debate

The Bureau took note:

- of the request of the Alliance of Liberals and Democrats for Europe Group to hold a current affairs debate on *Accountability and justice: a call to step up efforts for the establishment of the Special Tribunal for the Crime of Aggression against Ukraine*: decided to recommend to the Assembly to hold this debate and appointed Mr Frank Schwabe (Germany, SOC) as first speaker;
- of the request of the leaders of the five political groups to hold a current affairs debate on *The need for the respect of international law, peace and stability in broader Middle East*: decided to recommend to the Assembly to hold this debate and appointed Mr Piero Fassino (Italy, SOC) as first speaker
