Committee of Ministers

Committee on General Affairs

1. Role of the Council of Europe in the new pattern of organisation of Europe.
2. Statute of a Political Community of a supranational character.
3. Future position of the Saar.
4. Progress achieved in the sphere of European defence.

Committee on Economic Questions

5. Co-ordination between the economies of the Member States of the Council of Europe and those of the overseas countries having constitutional links with them.
6. Creation of European Companies enjoying a legal and administrative status agreed upon by Member States.
7. Removal of customs barriers and trade restrictions in Europe.
8. Institution of a European Monetary System.
9. Methods of encouraging, developing and co-ordinating investment and credit for the benefit of European industry.
10. Issue of a collective loan for European defence.

Committee on Social Questions

11. Common policy for Member States in social matters.
12. Exchange of war-cripples in order that they may benefit by therapeutic methods in the different Member Countries of the Council of Europe.

Committee on Cultural and Scientific Questions

13. Establishment of a European linguistic community based on the application of Anglo-French bilingualism.

Committee on Legal and Administrative Questions

14. Settlement of disputes by International Courts of Law.
15. Conclusion of a European Convention on Extradition in accordance with the desire of all the Members for common action in the legal field.
16. Simplification of frontier formalities for travellers.



Committee on Population and Refugees

17. Measures to be adopted for securing the integration in the economic system of refugees and surplus elements of population.

18. Methods of integration of refugees or surplus agricultural workers into the agricultural economy of the Member States of the Council of Europe.

Special Committee to watch over the interests of European nations not represented in the Council of Europe

19. Request to the international Olympic Committee to consider any suggestions which would enable political exiles to take part in the Olympic Games in future years.

Special Committee on Municipal and Regional Affairs

20. Enquiry into the national or international bodies connected with local government whose European character suggests that they might be suitably enrolled, in conditions to be specified hereafter, in a campaign to arouse ever wider support among the general public for the European idea.

21. Preliminary study of measures which might be recommended to enable local authorities to meet the new responsibilities likely to arise from the establishment of the European Communities.
