Work of the Ad Hoc Assembly

Motion for an Order

tabled by Mr Natale SANTERO and other members of the Assembly

The Assembly,

Considering that the Ad Hoc Assembly and its Constitutional Committee have based their work on Resolution 14 of the Consultative Assembly and on Opinion No. 3 relating to the best means of giving effect to the United Kingdom proposals, and that they have therefore provided for external and internal links with the Council of Europe;

Considering that for its part the Assembly should take all steps to concur with the conclusions reached by the Ad Hoc Assembly,

1. Decides that it should take the initiative by adopting a recommendation that the Committee of Ministers should give sympathetic consideration to any amendments to the Statute that may prove necessary and may later be presented in a draft Resolution of the Consultative Assembly;
2. Hereby instructs the competent Committees to prepare a draft Resolution for the purpose indicated above, as soon as the final results of the work of the Ad Hoc Assembly are known.
