6. Establishment of a procedure for consultation among European Delegations to world organisations.
7. Debate on the common efforts to be made by Western Europe to promote normal trade relations with the East.
8. Co-ordination between the economies of the Member States of the Council of Europe and those of the overseas countries having constitutional links with them.
9. Conclusion of a European Convention on Extradition, in compliance with the desire of all Members for common action in the legal field.
