## **Collaboration of the Consultative Assembly with the Committee for the Economic Reconstruction of Europe, set up by the Member Governments of E.C.S.C.**

### **Motion for an Order**

tabled by Mr Hellmut KALBITZER and other members of the Assembly

The Assembly,

Considering that, at its session held in Messina from June 1st to 3rd, the Council of the Foreign Ministers of the Member States of the Coal and Steel Community issued a statement that, in its opinion, Europe must first of all be built up in the economic sphere;

Considering that the Ministers have appointed a Committee for the purpose of working out corresponding proposals and have requested the Secretariat-General of the Council of Europe to collaborate with that committee, Request the Secretary-General, acting in co-operation with the competent committees, to acquaint the Preparatory Committee set up by the Messina Conference with the Consultative Assembly's views on the problems assigned to that Committee.
