Parliamentary Assembly

The Assembly instructs its Committees on General Affairs, on Economic Questions and on Social Questions and its Special Committee on Agriculture to prepare immediately after the signature of the Common Market and Euratom Treaties their opinions on these instruments, which could then be sent to the Standing Committee.
