



Recommendation 511 (1968)¹

Situation in Greece

Parliamentary Assembly

The Assembly,

1. Referring to its [Resolution 361\(1968\)](#),
2. Recommends that the Committee of Ministers invite member Governments :
 - a. to concert by every means at their disposal their attitude towards the present Greek regime ;
 - b. to use all their influence to ensure that Greece returns without delay to a regime which is democratic and parliamentary and respectful of human rights and fundamental freedoms ;
 - c. to see to it that the present Greek regime respects the undertakings it has given concerning the adoption and application of a democratic constitution, and that the promulgation of the Constitution is followed by free elections at the earliest possible date.
