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Azerbaijani civilians illegally imprisoned by Armenia

The recent provocation and aggressive acts by Armenian military forces in April 2016 have increased Armenia's rhetoric of hatred and enmity against Azerbaijanis. This situation will further worsen the position of Dilgam Askerov and Shahbaz Guliyev, who were illegally imprisoned while visiting their homeland and the graves of their relatives in the Kalbadjar region of the Republic of Azerbaijan occupied by Armenia.

The international community, including the OSCE Minsk Group, has on numerous occasions called on the Armenian authorities to take all necessary steps to return the two civilians to the Republic of Azerbaijan.
