Merabishvili v. Georgia Case

Written question No. 733 to the Committee of Ministers

The European Court of Human Rights decided on the case of the former Prime Minister of Georgia (*Merabishvili v. Georgia*) in 2017, and subsequently, according to the procedure on execution of judgments, the decision was transmitted to the Committee of Ministers.

In its judgment, the Court found a violation of Article 18 of the European Convention on Human Rights. This is a rare finding in the Court's practice and in the previous cases where a violation of this article was found it received particular attention from the Committee of Ministers. More than half a year has passed since the Court judgment and up to now, the Committee of Ministers has not yet discussed this case.
