Appoint a Special Committee to consider the question of Cyprus

Motion for a resolution

tabled by Mr Karl K. WISTRAND and other members of the Assembly

The Assembly,

Concerned at the dispute regarding the island of Cyprus;

Aware that the continuation of this situation may make any co-ordinated Western policy in the Eastern Mediterranean more difficult,

Decides in consequence to appoint a Special Committee of seven Members to be nominated by the Bureau from among the Representatives from countries not directly interested to consider the whole question of Cyprus and to report to the Assembly.
